THE CEPAC VISION

To know what their Conference is all about and to determine possible structures and programmes, it was necessary for the CEPAC Bishops to agree first on a common vision of the Conference. This is what they came up with:

The Episcopal Conference of the Pacific (CEPAC) is a community of Catholic bishops led by the Holy Spirit to live and promote the Way of Christ and the Tradition of the Church among its multicultural peoples, under the protection of Mary, Mother of Peace.

Almost every word in this vision has been broadly considered:

“Community” for instance, implies that CEPAC members do not simply come together once a year but that they must continue to be in community with one another in between meetings.

The expression “**Catholic bishops led by the Holy Spirit**” makes it clear that CEPAC is not a conference of Churches. While choosing this formula the CEPAC bishops were very much aware that they do not own the Holy Spirit.

“**The Way of Christ**” This shows that bishops are not just Gospel preachers but would like to live and promote more than a knowledge of Gospel values.

The words “**Its multicultural peoples**” are used rather than “peoples of the Pacific” to respect the Pacific nations who do not belong to CEPAC.

OBJECTIVES

No vision statement would be valid if not translated into objectives and programmes. The Bishops' Conference agreed on the following objectives:

1. Promote and share the vision of CEPAC
2. Help our people experience and celebrate faith in community
3. Promote the formation of our people and leaders on all levels
4. Develop the spiritual life of each person, and unify faith and social life
5. Promote the value and use of mass-media
6. Make known the recent social / political teachings of the Church
7. Promote the cause of Human Rights
8. Foster unity and reconciliation
9. Promote ecumenism in truth and in respect of different confessions.

REGIONS

These objectives had then to be expressed in concrete programmes, while testing at the same time if the existing CEPAC programmes would fit the objectives stated. Since one weakness of CEPAC's structure has always been its wide diversity serious thought was given to the possibility of implementing programmes on a regional rather than a conference level. In order not to overload the conference with too many structures, it was decided to create 3 regions in an informal fashion: a northern region (Micronesia), a French region (Francophone) and a Central Region.

THREE COLLECTIONS FOR PONTIFICAL MISSION SOCIETIES

1. WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

Always on the second last Sunday of OCTOBER. This collection is made during the Eucharistic Celebration and it is meant to be given entirely to the Pontifical Society of the Propagation of the Faith. This one and only collection on World Mission Sunday, shows the communion and solidarity of our Church with the poorest Churches, This collection belongs to the 1,250 poorest dioceses that depend on the Pontifical Missionary Society of the Propagation of the Faith for their life and work.

2. HOLY CHILDHOOD

Collection is for the benefit of children up to the age of 14 years. Holy Childhood Collection also known as 'Children Helping Children'. There is no special day set for this collection. It is up to the diocese to decide when and how this collection can be made. For example: some dioceses take up the Lenten Collection for Holy Childhood, but some have their own special day such as Epiphany, Holy Innocents, St Theresa of Lucieux or any other Feast that is significant for Children Helping Children.

3. ST PETER THE APOSTLE

Collection supports seminaries and first year novices of Religious Congregations.

Therefore, this Society is particularly concerned with one of the most urgent necessities for the progress of evangelization, the construction and maintenance of Seminaries in Mission Lands. Again, this Special Collection is up to each diocese again to decide when and how it can be done.

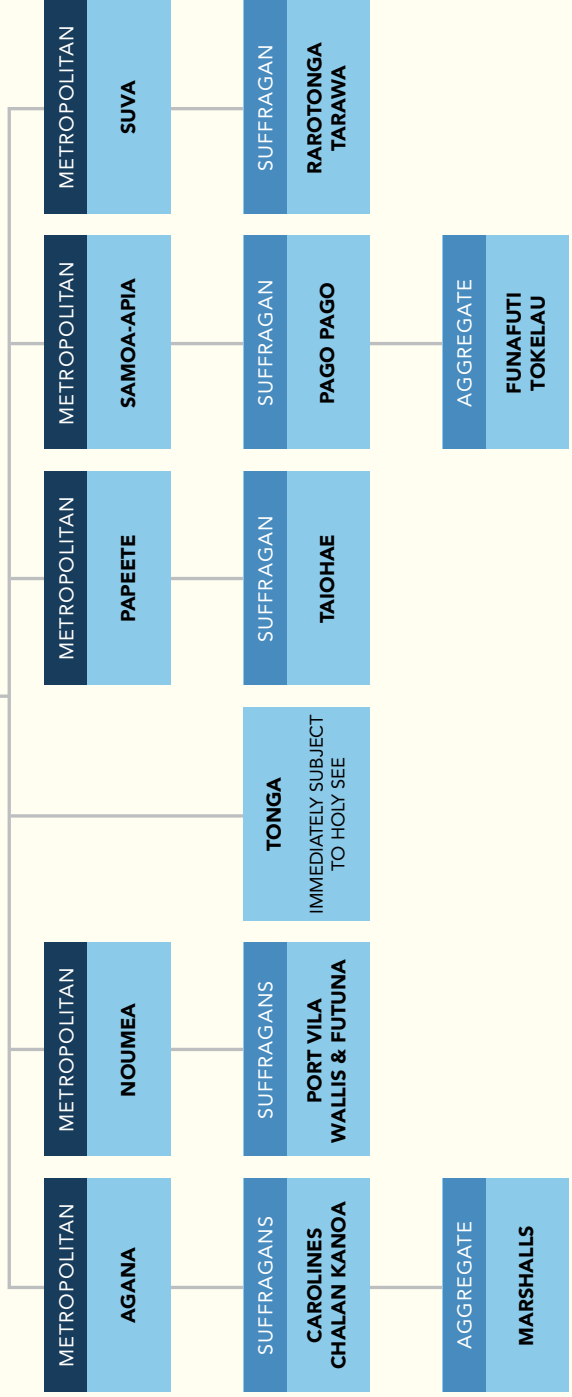
